PARTY PREPARATION LIST

1. Book your live entertainment, (That's Creative Comedy!), before you set a date and time for your party. That way, you can be sure that we are available! Then, invite your guests 3-6 weeks before the party.
2. Plan on your entertainer, (That's me!), to arrive about 30 minutes after your party starts. Have a semi-structured, activity for those early arrivers that can help them feel comfortable and use some of their excited energy. This way, everyone will have a chance to get there in time for a memorable show, where your child is a star!
3. Set the room temperature cooler than usual. A room full of children will increase the temperature and could make some feel sleepy.
4. Please turn off any TV's, radios, and such, during the show. We encourage family involvement, so, parents, please stay, enjoy, and take part in our show! (Please save visiting for the cake and ice cream time. Thank-you!)
5. Pre-lighting the birthday cake candles will help! When it is time to sing, the candles won't take as long to light, the second time, and you will have the matches or lighter ready. Set up the eating area where you don't care about spills.
6. Kodak Moment! Make sure film/batteries are ready and camera is at hand for this special occasion. Pictures to take: 1. The Cake! 2. The Star with the Entertainer! 3. During the show! 4. Opening present with the guest that brought it! (This is a great reminder of who gave that wonderful gift!)
7. Have an area ready for the show, and a table and two chairs ready for face-painting & balloons.
8. Please keep track of pets during the show. If you think they will be a distraction, please find another place for them during this time.
9. Put balloons on your mailbox, a sign in your yard, arrows... whatever you think is best, to make it easy for guests to find your party!
